Please note the following for the next session 2018-19


- ❖ In 2018-19 there will be no First Term, Mid Term and Final Term Exams for Grade 3 students. Only weekly tests will be there for Grade 3 students which will enable cumulative, continuous assessment of the children without the burden of formal exams.
- ❖ General knowledge/Value Education/Islamiat/French Exams will not be held with the First Term, Mid Term and Final Term Exams from next session 2018-19. There will be two exams for the above mentioned subjects per Term and average will be mentioned in the report cards. (Applicable for all classes)
- ❖ All the Term examination pass mark will be 50. Two exams per day will be conducted during the First Term and Mid Term Examinations and one exam per day will be conducted during the Final Term Examination.
- ❖ Senior School and Junior School Calendars 2018-19 are attached for your kind information. If any changes are made in dates, you will be informed separately via email and website notices.
- ❖ We shall also be introducing STEM to make the teaching-learning of Science more rewarding and deep rooted. You will receive a separate letter about that.


