DPS STS's Project Clementia Wins NASA Space Settlement Contest 2023



We are ecstatic to inform you that the design Project Clementia, prepared by six Grade 8 students of the DPS STS School Dhaka, has successfully won the international design competition "NASA Space Settlement Contest 2023." Project Clementia tied with an American school team's project to win the annual international design competition in the Grade 8 large group division. For context about how big this achievement is, there were 4,567 entries at this year's NASA Space Settlement Contest from 26,725 students hailing from 19 countries worldwide. The result of the competition usually comes out in the last week of March in the year of the competition.

The DPS STS Grade 8 students who prepared Project Clementia are Mohammad Mohaimin Uddin Naib, Md. Farzan Ali, Aayaat Gulfaam Mahmud, K A Adiyan Sadeque, Parikshit Singh, and Abrar Ehsan.

Another DPS STS project submission at the NASA Space Settlement Contest was prepared by seven Grade 7 students, and it was called Project Elysium. Both projects were submitted online on the AwardForce Platform of the National Space Society (NSS) within this year's deadline of 15th February 2023.

The programme coordinator for the DPS STS's project submissions at the NASA Space Settlement Contest was Mr. Ranjith S and subject-wise mentors were Mr. Shahed Bulbul Papon, Ms. Amena Dewan, Mr. Bishwanath Bhattachariya, Mr. Hans Ankur Byapari, and Mr. Ashish Chatterjee. It is due to the tireless support of the teachers, the students were able to achieve this amazing feat. Mr. Hans said that the project submission entailed work that is no less than a thesis, as the students had to prepare a 70-page submission in the space of two weeks.

The NASA Space Settlement Contest is a prestigious international space settlement design competition being held annually since 1994. In the competition, the participants are not given any other requirements besides the one which states that the submitted project must focus on a free space settlement concept. According to the details of the competition shared on the NSS website, 'settlements may not be on a planet or moon, although support activities such as mining might be part of the project. Settlements must be permanent homes, and not temporary work camps. Designs, original research, essays, stories, models, artwork, or any other orbital space settlement-related materials may be submitted. This competition is open for Grades 7-12 students and is sponsored by the NASA Ames Research Center and the National Space Society (NSS). The Daily Star Gives 22nd O' and A' Level Awards







73 DPS STS School Dhaka students received awards at the Daily Star's 22nd O' and A' Level Awards ceremony, held on 4th March 2023 at the Shaheed Shohrawardi Indoor Stadium, Mirpur. The awards were given to the DPS STS students for their outstanding performance in the Cambridge Assessment International Education (CAIE) board examinations held in the year 2022; 48 students received awards for obtaining an "A" grade or above in six or more IGCSE O' Level subjects, and 25 students received awards for achieving "A" grade or above in three or more GCE A' Level subjects.

Three of the 73 DPS STS students received special awards for achieving Outstanding Cambridge Learner Awards - 2022, which they received for achieving the highest marks in a particular subject in the entire country. Lamia Abdullah and Mashriq Afnan achieved the country's highest marks in the IGCSE O' Level subject Additional Mathematics, and Tasfia Ahmed achieved it in GCE A' Level Biology. Some of our students also performed in the cultural segment for this prestigious awards ceremony.





DPS STS Holds International Model United Nations



The sixth edition of the DPS Model United Nations (MUN) conference was held on the Senior School campus from the 9th to the 13th of March 2023. It was a four-day MUN conference, which kicked off with a lovely and colourful cultural program at the Senior School's auditorium on 9th March and ended with a Gala Night at the Ballroom of the Hotel Le Meridien Dhaka, on 13th March.

This year the DPS STS School Dhaka organised their annual MUN conference on an international scale, with delegates attending from foreign schools as well. Therefore, the sixth edition of the DPS STS MUN was called and referred to with the acronym DPSIMUN VI. Close to 2000 people signed up when the registration opened, however, considering the experience and overall suitability of the applicants, around 700 delegates were shortlisted and invited to the conference. There were students from schools such as Cibola High School (US), Yew Chung International School of Shanghai (China), Scholastica, Sunbeams, Aga Khan School, Sir John Wilson School, Sunnydale, St. Joseph Higher Secondary School, Viqarunnisa Noon School and College, Holy Cross College and others.

The special guests of the opening ceremony were dignitaries such as the Coordinator of the UN Bangladesh Resident Office Ms. Fahmida Sultana and the Operations Manager of UN Women in Bangladesh Ms. Reshma Khan Zaman. The Principal of the DPS STS School Dhaka Dr. Shivananda CS gave the opening remarks. Speeches were also given by student representatives from the organising committee of the conference, the Head of the English Department of Senior Section and the MUN Coordinator Mr. M Shamim Hosen. The ceremony was interspersed with songs and dances performed by the students.

On the second day, the delegates wore cultural attire, and a special event called *Aloy Akaash Mela* was organized by the DPS STS students. The event featured performances by the bands Auvro The Band and Ograjjo. A few stalls providing popular street snacks of Bangladesh were also arranged on the volleyball ground, decorated with a large design like a canopy of colourful ribbons and lanterns. On the third day, the massively popular and iconic rock band of Bangladesh Nemesis performed for the MUN participants. There were lots of food and beverage stalls in the school for the benefit of the Delegates during the first three days of the event, in which committee sessions were held. And as always the Gala event of the MUN, which was attended by all the high officials of the school, was conducted so beautifully at the Hotel Le Meridien Dhaka, that it may remain permanently etched in the memories of all the delegates who attended the sixth edition, but first international, DPS STS Model United Nations.

The DPS STS Rock Fest 3.0 was held on 4th March 2023, at the football ground of the Senior School campus with great success.

Grade 9 Visits Atomic Research Centre, National Institute of Biotechnology



The DPS STS School Dhaka organized a field trip to the Atomic Research Centre and National Institute of Biotechnology - both located at Savar, Dhaka - for grade 9 students on Wednesday, 1st March 2023. The students on arrival at the facility of the Atomic Energy Research Establishment were given a brief introduction to the history of the centre. Students were taken to different laboratory infrastructures present. The tour was conducted by different officials responsible for the assigned labs. After each brief a short Q&A session was conducted to test if the students were absorbing the knowledge being imparted to them.

Upon arriving at the facility of the National Institute of Biotechnology (NIB), the students were given a brief introduction to the centre and the eight laboratories present. The students were then taken to different labs where they had interactive sessions with the instructors. They also saw some of the research being done in the field of Biotechnology. The Grade 7 students were taken on a field trip to the National Martyrs' Memorial at Savar on Saturday, 18th February 2023. The students visited the main structure and the artificial lake and took several photos enthusiastically. The National Monument mesmerised the students with its 150 feet' highest plate, majestically rising towards the sky when seen from the front. From the side, the parabolic drama morphs into seven progressively rising triangles. The serene environment, the majestic view, and the calm lake kept the students in awe. Later, the students settled down and wrote a few lines in both English and Bangla about their experience of visiting such a sight. The overall, In-charge of this field trip were Ms. Tahmina Binte Aziz and Ms. Nusrat Jahan.

Grades 3-4 Goes on Film Field Trip


