

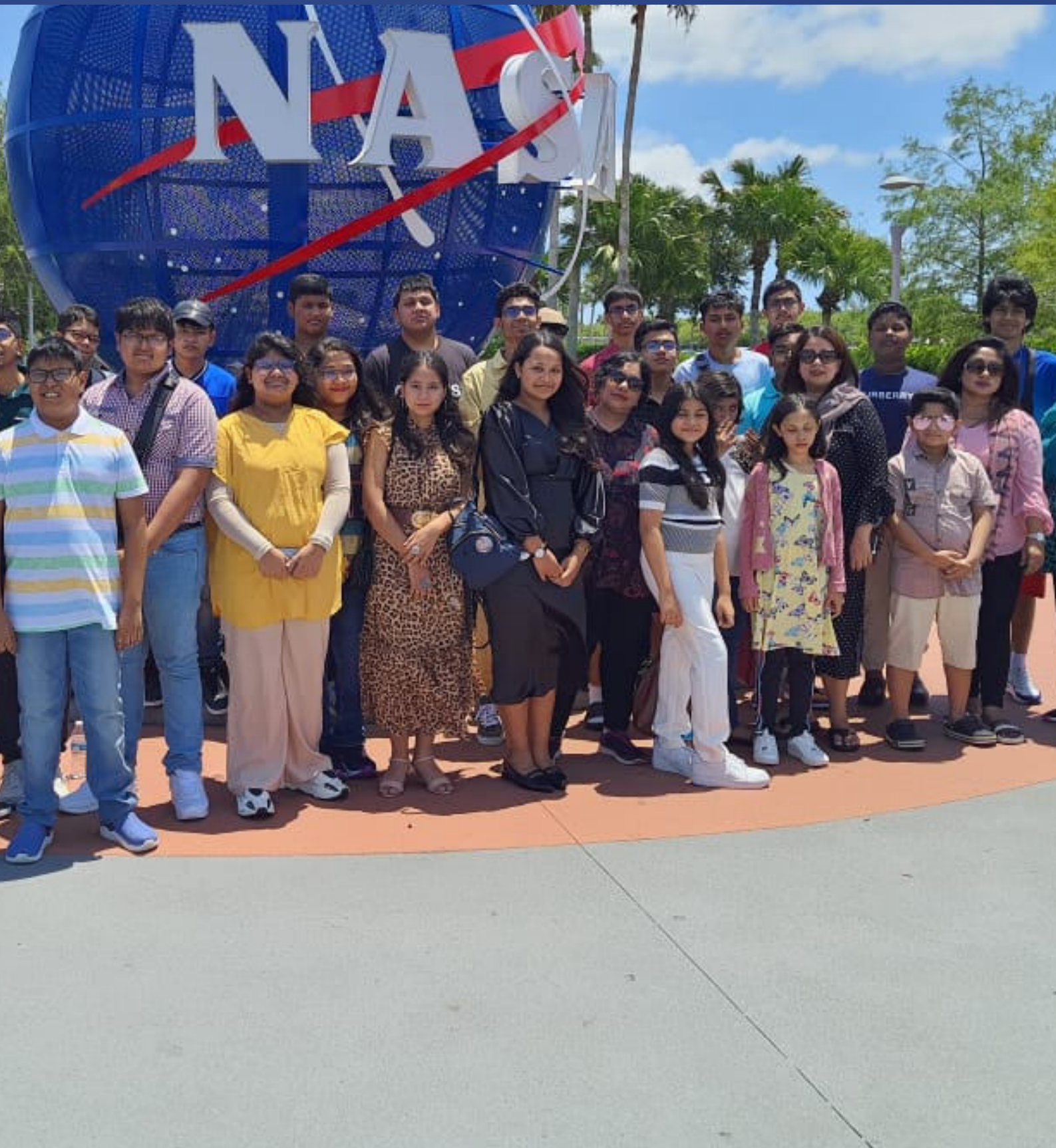

DPS STS students, teachers visit NASA, MIT, Harvard



A group of 59 people from the DPS STS School Dhaka, including students, parents, and teachers, are currently in the United States of America (USA) for an 11-night and 12-day educational program. A perfect amalgamation of fun and engaging learning, the program includes a visit to the Kennedy Space Center, Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT), Harvard University, Niagara Falls, and more. A total of 28 students from grades 3 to 10 of DPS STS School Dhaka are participating in this highly challenging, enriching, and engaging program. Apart from students and teachers, DPS STS has also included their parents in the trip.

Educational tours are incredibly enriching for students, allowing them to learn different perspectives, cultures, and ways of life in foreign regions. By participating in an educational tour, students can broaden their understanding of the world which, in turn, fosters key skills like independence, problem-solving, and teamwork. Aligning with this philosophy, DPS STS School Dhaka arranged an educational tour such as this one, which includes visits to some of the most enthralling destinations in the United States (US). The students, parents, and teachers of DPS STS are getting the opportunity to enjoy the culture, food, history, and art of the US through this program.

First, the DPS STS group visited MIT and Harvard University in Boston, Massachusetts, where students interacted with Professors and participated in a robotics workshop. The group then visited the iconic destinations of the US, such as the Empire State Building, Statue of Liberty, Central Park, Niagara Falls, and many more. The main highlight of this educational tour is the visit to the Kennedy Space Center – the heart of NASA for a multi-sensory experience.

In this regard, Dr Shivananda CS, Principal of the DPS STS School Dhaka, said, “During this trip, the DPS STS students, teachers, and parents visited NASA’s Kennedy Space Center. It was a great learning journey for them. They were accompanied by able teachers who guided them to learn and make the most out of the trip. One exciting thing about this trip is that they also visited MIT University, where they met the teachers there, learned their ways and best practices, and absorbed by interacting. Students prepare for Summer Exchange Program in July

A group 123 people, including students, teachers and parents are set to participate



Like every year, DPS STS School Dhaka's Summer Exchange Programme is back. The ten-day exchange programme is scheduled between the 6th to 16th of July for one group, and the 7th to 17th of July 2023 for another group, and includes visits to Rome, Paris, Scotland and Cambridge, United Kingdom. The DPS STS students will perform songs, dance, and art exhibitions in the Summer Exchange Programme, for which reason, the students prepared artworks and practised songs ahead of time. A group of 123 people - 66 students accompanied by 12 teachers, including the Head of DPS STS Senior School Tarana Majid Ahmed, Senior School Computer Science Teacher Jubaer Uddin Prince, and the Head of the Art Department Mr Md Nasiruddin Ripon, and 45 parents - will be participating in this year's Summer Exchange Programme, which is being organized by Dusemond Study Programmes - a UK-based organization.

The Summer Exchange Programme includes visits to the Sistine Chapel in Rome, the Louvre Museum in Paris, the British Museum in the United Kingdom, Loch Ness in Scotland, and many other culturally significant places. The trip will be rounded off with a lovely cultural event at Cambridge. A football match will also occur between DPS STS students and local British students.
